



Are you a person living in Edmonton with a permanent, temporary disability or mobility challenge? You can enrol in the Assisted Snow Removal pilot program through a simplified process.

The Assisted Snow Removal Program supports Edmontonians with disabilities and mobility challenges by arranging for subcontractors to clear snow from accessible walkways and public sidewalks adjacent to private property.



Participants of the Dedicated Accessible Transit Service (DATS) or the Assisted Waste Collection program can enrol in the Program through a simplified process.

HOW THE PROCESS WORKS:

- Visit edmonton.ca/AssistedSnowRemoval and complete the enrolment form.
- * We will reach out to confirm the status of your application.
- Once enrolled, your address will be added to our snow removal inventory.
- Services will begin within 24 hours after a citywide snowfall ends and at least 2 cm of snow has accumulated.

The Assisted Snow Removal Program will start accepting participants on Wednesday, October 23, 2024, at 8 a.m. (M.T)
